



MODULE TIPS



You can experience each OPEPP Module through the following reflective formats:

1. Individually and at your personal pace
2. In a group setting with an OPEPP instructor leading 4-5 Synchronous Sessions & asynchronous content
3. In a group setting with a local agency or OPEPP instructor & as part of a “design your own format”

Pre- Test	Each module begins by taking a pre-assessment giving a picture of your understanding.
Units	Each module is broken down into at least 10 units.
Introductory Scenario	Each unit begins with a scenario or practical story related to the content.
Reflective Questions	Next, the participants fill out reflective questions in their notes or as part of their assigned work through the workshop.
Slideshow	Each unit includes a pre-recorded slideshow with a script.
Overview	Each unit starts with an overview including exposure to key ideas.
Reflective Questions	At times reflective questions will be shared to help participants take note of learning.
Content	Each unit includes content related to the unit’s theme. These include: key terms and definitions, strategies, activities, and tools for the field.
Reflective Questions	At times reflective questions will be shared to help participants take note of learning.
Take Notes	Each unit revisits the introductory scenario and ends with more reflective questions.
Post Test	Finally, the participants will take a post-assessment to evaluate their learning & growth

Other information to know...

Contact Hours: Participants will receive contact hours for each of these sessions if they complete the module in full on their own or with a group and receive post test scores that show 80% mastery.

Workshops: Several times a year, OPEPP hosts these modules as workshops with synchronous sessions taught by experienced OPEPP instructors. Those who attend these and complete all additional reflective tasks are eligible for additional contact hours.

Citing OPEPP: All professional development offerings through OPEPP are open access and FREE to use. We just ask that you site OPEPP in your use of them.
